Route Overview

Yanyang Lake



Urban Version of Chaka Salt Lake – Yanyang Lake: Designed with the Duanyan inkstone as its prototype, Yanyang Lake is a new landmark that blends elements of ecology, landscape, and Lingnan culture. The area features egrets soaring, seasonal flowers in bloom, and countless scenic views, presenting a beautiful and vibrant portrait of modern Lingnan style to visitors. The Waterfront Platform is the park's most distinctive feature, located in front of the main square. The largest "hui" (回) shaped platform represents the urban version of Chaka Salt Lake and is known as the "Mirror of the Sky" in Zhaoqing. The Japanese-style lakeside greenway, with its overall blue-gray tone, complements the surrounding lush lake and floral scenery.

Dinghu Mountain



The scenic area is lush with trees, with over 4,000 hectares of primeval forest, earning it the nickname "Oasis on the Tropic of Cancer." It is home to more than 2,000 species of wild plants and over 300 species of cultivated plants. Additionally, more than 170 species of birds, over 30 species of mammals, and other rare animals live here, making its biological resources extremely abundant. It is known as the "Human and Biosphere," "Living Natural Museum," and "Green Treasure House." Key attractions include the famous Lingnan temple **Qingyun Temple, Feishui Pool**, and **Zhongshan Swimming Pool**. Along the way, visitors can also see the mystical **Enyuan Tree** at the Half-Mountain Pavilion, as well as magnificent and unique plant species. In the **Tianhu District**, visitors can enjoy views of **Dinghu**

Mountain and the Baoding Garden, which houses the world's largest bronze cauldron, the Nine-Dragon Cauldron, as well as the Longhuang Inkstone.

Seven Star Crags



The Seven Star Crags scenic area consists of seven unique peaks—Langfeng, Yuping, Shishi, Tianzhu, Chanchu, Xianzhang, and Apoi—as well as five major lakes: East Lake, Qinglian Lake, Central Lake, Bohai Lake, and Lihu Lake. The natural scenery is exceptional and has long been praised as the "First Wonder of Lingnan," "Fairyland on Earth," and a "Natural Landscape of Scenic Beauty." With its green mountains and clear waters, the area offers a perfect blend of lake and mountain views, resembling the limestone peaks of Yangshuo and the waters of West Lake. As one moves through the area, the changing scenery makes it feel like stepping into an otherworldly paradise.

Ruyuan Grand Canyon



The **Ruyuan Grand Canyon** is a provincial-level nature reserve located in the southwestern part of Ruyuan County, within the southern foothills of the Nanling Mountains. It borders Qujiang to the east, and the areas of Yingde to the west and south, including the Chengtou Waterfall in Ruyuan County. The reserve primarily protects the South Asian subtropical evergreen broadleaf forests and its rare plant and animal species. Established in 1998, the Guangdong Ruyuan Grand Canyon Provincial Nature Reserve covers a total area of 3,673 hectares and is classified as a forest ecosystem type nature reserve.

The Ruyuan Grand Canyon, also known as the Guangdong Grand Canyon, is located in Dabu Town, Ruyuan County, Shaoguan City, Guangdong Province. The canyon stretches for 15 kilometers between Dabu Town in Shaoguan and Boluo Town in Yingde, with a maximum depth of over 400 meters. It is acclaimed as "the most beautiful canyon in Guangdong."

Danxia Mountain



Danxia Mountain is located in Renhua County, Shaoguan City, Guangdong Province, covering an area of 219 square kilometers. It is named Danxia Mountain due to the reddish sandstone cliffs that "resemble the color of cinnabar and shine like brilliant rosy clouds." Danxia Mountain has been recognized by UNESCO as a World Natural Heritage site and a Global Geopark. It is also a national AAAA-rated scenic area, a national nature reserve, and a national geopark in China.

The main peak of Danxia Mountain, **Changlao Peak Scenic Area**, is the oldest attraction in the Danxia scenic area. Danxia Mountain first gained attention from the public due to Changlao Peak. From a distance, amidst a group of stone cliffs in various shapes, one peak stands out prominently, resembling a monk's hat. This peak is called **Monk's Hat Peak**, and the surrounding cliffs are naturally referred to as **Changlao Peak**. Climbing the iron ladder and rope to the top allows visitors to enjoy a panoramic view of the stunning Danxia landscape, with numerous uniquely shaped peaks such as **Sleeping Beauty**, **Teapot Peak**, **Monk's Hat Peak**, **Candle Peak**, and **Sisters Peak**.
