6. Introduction to Jiangsu Agricultural Expo Park

Jiangsu Agricultural Expo Park is situated in the northern subtropical humid monsoon climate zone, characterized by distinct monsoons, four clear seasons, ample sunshine, and abundant rainfall. The Zhenjiang Huanggang Temple Provincial Forest Park is also located within its boundaries.

The Expo Park boasts a propagation base for high-quality forage seeds, which are specifically cultivated for China's southern hilly regions. In addition, visitors can explore five other cultivation demonstration bases, showcasing soilless turf, seasonal fresh fruits, in-season vegetables, indoor air-purifying rootless plants, and plants with colored foliage.

The Expo Park features five functional zones: the Soilless Turf Demonstration Zone, Facility Agriculture Zone, Seasonal Fruit Zone, Ecological Forest Zone, and Circular Agriculture Zone. It also houses four thematic halls: the Modern Agriculture Pavilion, Urban Agriculture Pavilion, Mushroom Culture Pavilion, and Farming Culture Pavilion.

For those seeking leisure, sightseeing, or science education, the Expo Park provides diverse spaces like the Ecological

Avenue, Hundred Herbs Garden, Chinese Rose Garden, and Begonia Garden.
