VI. Introduction to Scenic Area

Nanjing Zijin Mountain National Forest Park comprises three core scenic areas: Sun

Yat-sen Mausoleum, Ming Xiaoling Mausoleum, and Linggu Scenic Area along with other regional scenic spots. The key scenic spots include one UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site: Ming Xiaoling Mausoleum, one of China's first 20th-century architectural heritage sites: Sun Yat-sen Mausoleum, a key national buddhist temple in Han Chinese regions: Linggu Temple, and the Far East's top luxurious villa: Soong May-ling Palace. Zijin Mountain (Zhongshan) where the Nanjing Zijin Mountain National Forest Park is located hosts 42 protected cultural relics at various levels and over 200 all kinds of historic interest. Zijin Mountain is a important city forest greenbelt with a forest coverage rate of 76.8%, it is home to 701 species of native wild seed plants across 113 families and 386 genera, as well as over 1,600 animal resources [114]. It is a national forest park integrating ecology, culture, recreation and leisure.

In 2003, Nanjing Zijin Mountain National Forest Park was rated as national level forest park. In 2007, the Sun Yat-sen Mausoleum Scenic Area where the Nanjing Zijin Mountain National Forest Park is located was rated as national AAAAA tourist attraction.
