

Congress Overview



The 23rd WCSS, dubbed the "Olympics of Soil Science", will take place in Nanjing, China for the first time from June 7 to 12, 2026. This marks a historic milestone in China's century-long journey in soil science and provides a pivotal opportunity for global scholars to engage in a shared dialogue on "Soil and the Shared Future for Humanity".

Since its inception in 1927, the WCSS has evolved into the world's most influential academic platform in soil science. Its focus has broadened over the past century to include interdisciplinary subjects such as climate change, food security and biodiversity—reflecting humanity's cognitive shift from "conquering nature" to "revering nature"

China first participated in the WCSS in 1935. At the 21st Congress in Rio de Janeiro (2018), a delegation of nearly 300 Chinese scholars, representing 7% of total attendees, took part, and the SSSC successfully secured the bid to host the event in 2026. At the 2024 centennial celebration of the International Union of Soil Sciences (IUSS), China dispatched a delegation of nearly 200 participants—the largest among non-host countries—and chaired multiple sessions. These achievements lay a solid foundation for the forthcoming 23rd WCSS, and underscore China's rise as one of the largest and most dynamic soil science communities globally.

The 23rd WCSS will take place at the Nanjing International Expo Center, nestled at the foot of Purple Mountain and near the site of China's earliest soil research institute. The Congress is expected to yield several breakthroughs that bridge traditional wisdom with contemporary soil management practices, such as the launch of thematic forums "The Civilizational History of Soil", "Entrepreneurship", and "New-Generation Farmers". It will also see the signing of the "Soil Health Declaration", marking the beginning of deepened soil science cooperation among the Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) countries. This Congress is more than just a global academic gathering; it symbolizes a fundamental shift in human perspective from viewing soil as a resource to be exploited, to embracing it as a living community that needs to be cared for.

In June 2026, let us gather in Nanjing to unlock the soil code for a sustainable civilization!
