

Congress Overview



The 23rd World Congress of Soil Science (23rd WCSS) will be held in Nanjing from June 7 to 12, 2026. Held once every four years, the congress is known as the "Olympics" of international soil science community. Its inaugural landing in China in 2026 marks not only a milestone in WCSS's century journey in soil science, but also presents a key opportunity for global scholars to engage in dialogues around the theme of "Soils and the Shared Future for Humanity".

Since its inaugural forum in Washington D.C. in 1927, the WCSS has evolved into the world's most influential soil science gathering. China began its engagement with the WCSS in 1935. At the largest-to-date 2018 Rio de Janeiro Congress which attracted over 4,000 scholars worldwide, nearly 300 Chinese participants (or 7% of the total) participated and the SSSC successfully bid to host the 2026 event. The 2022 Glasgow Congress featured a speech by Prince Charles, while at the 2024 Centennial Congress of the International Union of Soil Sciences (IUSS), China fielded the largest non-host delegation (nearly 200 members) and chaired multiple sub-forums. These milestones signal China's rise as a leading and innovative force in global soil science community, laying robust foundation for the upcoming 2026 congress.

This congress has received strong support from the State Council, the Chinese Academy of Sciences, the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs, the China Association for Science and Technology, and the Nanjing Municipal People's Government. It will be held in Nanjing International Expo Center at the foot of Zijin Mountain. It is expected to welcome 4,000 participants, comprising around 1,500 international representatives and 2,500 domestic representatives. The theme of the congress, which combines academic advancements with practical applications, is highly in line with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, as well as China's strategies for national food security, ecological civilization development and rural revitalization. It represents not only an academic feast, but also a testament to humanity's shift from "resource plundering" to protecting the "community of life" in terms of soil knowledge. In May 2025, the congress has received more than 120 session proposals, and in July, it opened global registration and abstract submission.

In June 2026, let us gather in Nanjing to unlock the soil code for a sustainable civilization!
