

Nanjing Metropolitan Area



CITY CLUSTER OF RAIL TRANSIT

A comprehensive "one-hour" urban transportation network within the metropolitan area has been basically built.

LIVABLE LIVING CIRCLE

Deepen the cooperation in public service sectors such as employment, education, healthcare, culture, and tourism, gradually achieving unified policies, synchronized operations, and shared development in public services.


The Nanjing Metropolitan Area is the first crossprovincial metropolitan area officially approved for development by the National Development and Reform Commission. Centered around Nanjing, Jiangsu Province, it encompasses closely connected surrounding cities, mainly including: Nanjing City, Zhenjiang City (Jingkou, Runzhou, and Dantu Districts, and Jurong City), Yangzhou City (Guangling, Hanjiang, and Jiangdu Districts, and Yizheng City), Huai'an City (Xuyi County), Wuhu City, Anhui Province (Jinghu, Yijiang, and Jiujiang Districts), Ma'anshan City, Anhui Province (Huashan, Yushan, and Bowang Districts, He County, and Dangtu County), Chuzhou City, Anhui Province (Langya and Nanqiao Districts, Lai'an County, and Tianchang City), Xuancheng City, Anhui Province (Xuanzhou District), with the area covering 27,000 square kilometers. The extended planning area includes the entire territories of the eight cities (Nanjing, Zhenjiang, Yangzhou, Huai'an, Wuhu, Ma'anshan, Chuzhou, and Xuancheng), as well as Jintan District and Liyang City of Changzhou, totaling 66,000 square kilometers. In 2023, the Nanjing Metropolitan Area achieved a regional GDP of 5,104.946 billion yuan, accounting for 4.0% of the national economic output.

INDUSTRIAL INNOVATION CIRCLE

Promote the collaborative construction of industrial parks, and accelerate the development of cross-city integrated demonstration zones between Nanjing-Chuzhou and Nanjing-Ma'anshan. Facilitate the industrial transfer to Lai'an Chahe Rail Transit Equipment Industrial Park and Dingyuan Economic Development Zone in Anhui (Dingyuan Salt Chemical Industrial Park in Anhui).

RESOURCE ALLOCATION CIRCLE

Become a gateway and hub in the planning of Yangtze River Delta Integration, connecting the east and the west, the north and the south, the sea and land. Build itself into a key node in domestic circulation and a strategic channel in the new development paradigm, where the domestic market serves as the mainstay and domestic and international markets reinforce each other.



Nanjing Overview

Located along China's developed eastern coast, Nanjing (or "Ning" for short), is a sub-provincial city and the capital of Jiangsu province. The world's third longest river—the Yangtze River—traverses the city's southwest region to the northeast. Nanjing covers an area of 6,587 square kilometers. Over 9.5470 million people reside in Nanjing, and the city administers the following 11 districts, namely Xuanwu, Qinhuai, Jianye, Gulou-Qixia, Yuhuatai, Jiangning, Pukou, Luhe, Lishui, and Gaochun. Nanjing currently boasts one state-level new area—Nanjing Jiangbei New Area, China (Jiangsu) Pilot Free Trade Zone Nanjing Area, one state-level high-tech zone—Nanjing Hightech Industrial Development Zone, and two state-level economic and technological development zones— Nanjing Economic and Technological Development Zone and Jiangning Economic and Technological Development Zone.

Historical and cultural background

Reputed as the "ancient capital of six dynasties" and a "metropolis of ten dynasties", Nanjing boasts a civilization history of over 6,000 years, nearly 3,000 years as a capital city, and about 450 years as a capital. Nanjing has the longest preserved Ming city wall, the World Heritage Site, Ming Xiaoling, and Nanjing Yunjin Brocade Craft and Nanjing Scripture Engraving which are selected into the UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage Lists.

Eco-friendly livable city

Nanjing's natural biodiversity and environment bring together mountains, forests, and rivers and urban areas for a truly livable and green city. With Zhongshan scenic spot as a notable landmark, the city locates along the Yangtze River and is interspersed by Xuanwu Lake. Richly endowed with an urban landscape and a natural environment, Nanjing is also encircled by the Qinhuai River. Nanjing's environmental quality index (EQI) has topped among cities in the Yangtze River Delta region for a long time. The city is known as an International Garden City, a National Forest City, a National Ecological City, and is a nationally-ranked destination for tourism.

Science and education resources

Nanjing is a national hub for science and education and a gathering place for talents, home to 51 institutions of higher learning (excluding military academies). In 2023, the city had 1.0075 million undergraduate and postgraduate students, with 274,600 graduates. Nanjing has 95 academicians from the Chinese Academy of Sciences and the Chinese Academy of Engineering, 629 above provincial-level engineering technology research centers, and 93 provincial-level or higher key laboratories, including 33 national key laboratories. The annual R&D expenditure accounted for over 3.82% of its GDP, with 146.8 valid invention patents per 10,000 people.

Efficient transportation

Nanjing features three transportation hubs of high-speed railway, airport and inland port, as well as five modes of transport including air, rail, water, highway, and pipeline. The city's comprehensive transit systems make it a well-operated transportation hub. Lukou International Airport covers the domestic market, as well as to Asia, Europe, and Americas Nanjing South Railway Station is a key hub of China's national high-speed rail network, and the Port of Nanjing operates as key hub port in the Yangtze River Economic Belt construction. The city also has an important position as the national Internet backbone straight point and one of the first batch of cities in future network backbone connections. By the end of 2023, the city had completed 14 urban rail transit lines (including 2 tram lines) with an operating mileage of 459.4 kilometers (including 16.71 kilometers of tram lines). The total annual passenger volume of the metro system reached 1.01 billion. The total passenger traffic volume was 1.569752 billion, with a passenger turnover of 21.41 billion passenger-kilometers.

Thriving economy and industries

Nanjing has a strong economic foundation. In 2023, the city's GDP reached 1,742.14 billion yuan, representing a year-on-year increase of 4.6%, ranking among the top 10 large and medium-sized cities in China in terms of economic scale. The general public budget revenue was 162 billion yuan, up by 4%. The city's fixed-asset investment reached 576.364 billion yuan, and the total retail sales of consumer goods reached 820.107 billion yuan, up by 4.7%. The actual use of foreign capital was 4.94 billion US dollars, an increase of 1.9%. The city's total import and export volume reached 565.99 billion yuan. A total of 130 new overseas investment projects were added throughout the year, with a committed investment volume of 660 million US dollars from the Chinese side, a year-on-year increase of 20%. The per capita disposable income of all residents reached 72,112 yuan, an increase of 4.5%.

Located in the Low-carbon Ecological Core Demonstration Zone in the south of Hexi New Town, Nanjing International Friendship Park (formerly known as Hexi Ecological Park) covers a total area of 21.7 hectares. As a low-carbon, ecological and intelligent urban park, it opened to the public in June 2014. To meet people's ever-growing needs for a better life and foster a broad global perspective, the CPC Municipal Committee and the People's Government of Nanjing decided in 2018 to build the park into a platform for Naniing's international exchanges. which was officially renamed Nanjing International Friendship Park later in 2019, Naniing International Friendship Park is jointly constructed and managed by the Foreign Affairs Office of Nanjing Municipal People's Government and the Development and Construction Headquarters of Nanjing Hexi New Town. Sculptures designed by Nanjing's sister cities will be placed in the park successively. An array of national flags of the countries where Nanjing's sister cities are located has been set up along the lakeshore, and a new international friendship forest has also been arranged. Two rest areas in the park can provide tourists with urban book bars and parentchild space, where they can make a pit stop. The sunken plaza outside the exhibition hall serves as an area to hold theme parties from time to time, aiming to develop into a model international city living room. Nanjing Sister Cities Exhibition Hall is located underground in the park. With a floor area of 1,100 square meters, the exhibition hall has 7 showrooms including Asia Hall, Europe Hall, America Hall, Oceania Hall and Africa Hall, and is home to nearly 170 gifts from sister cities. including sculptures, paintings, handicrafts, commemorative plagues and a variety of interesting interactive devices, displaying in a vivid way Nanjing's international friendly exchanges and cooperation.



Ticketing and inquiry services

How to buy tickets:

Foreigners may use the following documents to purchase train tickets under the real-name system.

- Foreigners permanent residence permit / foreigner's permanent residence ID card
- Foreigner's entry-exit permit
- Diplomatic identity card / Consular ID card
- Seaman's certificate
- Foreigner Identity Certificate Issued by PRC Ministry of Foreign Affairs

Option 1: Purchase at the ticket window of the railway station or through an agent.

Option 2: Complete passport registration information on official website. Then tickets will be able to be booked online, and can be picked up at the railway station window or via an agent sales office.

*The automatic ticket machine only accepts second-generation Chinese ID cards for ticket collection. Collecting tickets with passports can only be done manually at the station ticket window. Passengers can view the departure

and arrival time of trains and buy, change, or refund tickets on both the official website or mobile application.

Expressway

Nanjing has a road network of expressway shaped as "belt + radiation", connecting Shanghai, Hangzhou, Xuancheng, Wuhu (Ma'anshan), Hefei, Bengbu, Xuzhou, Lianyungang, Nantong and other cities. Nanjing has a total mileage of expressways up to 557 kilometers, and in terms of the density of expressways, Nanjing ranks first in the province and in the forefront of subprovincial cities in China. Nanjing will make further efforts to develop a network pattern of "two belts, two horizontal expressways and fourteen radial expressways" with a planned mileage of 665 kilometers. The "two belts" include belt freeway and metropolitan ring expressway; "two horizontal expressways" include Changzhou-Ma'anshan Expressway and Liyang-Wuhu Expressway; "fourteen radial expressways" include 14 expressways such as Shanghai-Nanjing Expressway, Nanjing-Hangzhou Expressway, Nanjing-Xuancheng Expressway, Nanjing-Ma'anshan Expressway, Nanjing-Hefei Expressway, Nanjing-Yancheng Expressway and Nanjing-Nantong Expressway. All are conducive to grounding the dual highways between Shanghai and Nanjing, Nanjing and Hangzhou, Nanjing and Hefei in Yangtze River Delta, and the direct expressways in districts and cities.

Port Services

Nanjing Port is an international, comprehensive and multifunctional hub port for river and sea transshipment, a national coastal and Class A port open to the outside. It is crucial to Nanjing as a regional shipping logistics center. Based on -12.5m deep-water channel in the Yangtze River, three highway-railway-waterway combined transportation hubs, namely, Longtan, Xiba and Xinshengwei, have been built. Besides, Nanjing Port is the only port that caters to seamless connection between container railway and waterway in the lower reaches of Yangtze River. It plans nine freight port areas such as Xinshengwei and Longtan, and four passenger port areas such as Pukou and Shangyuanmen, with 247 productive berths and an annual designed throughput capacity of 346 million tons. As of the end of 2023, the port of Nanjing has a total of 190 productive berths along the river, with an annual designed throughput capacity of 200 million tons. In 2023, the port completed a cargo throughput of 275 million tons and a container throughput of 3.46 million TEUs.

How to buy tickets for Nanjing Metro

Ticket vending machine (TVM)

Select the destination station on the touch screen of the automatic ticket vending machine in the boarding station, and press the destination station name;

After selecting the number of purchases through the passenger display, the amount you need to pay will be displayed on the display screen. You can pay in cash or by scanning the QR code;

- (1) Pay in cash: Insert sufficient banknotes and coins into the cash slot; TVM will automatically sell tickets and refund change through the ticket port; If TVM fails to recognize banknotes and coins, TVM returns coins through the ticket port and banknotes through the refund port for collection and replacement. The banknote can be taken out or replaced.
- (2) Pay by scanning the QR code: Scan the QR code on the display through UnionPay app and Alipay app to pay the ticket;

TVM will automatically sell tickets through the ticket port.

Ride metro with the official Nanjing Metro app

Open Nanjing Metro app and find the Transport QR code. Scan the QR code to check in and out the station.

"Nanjing Metro Electronic Card" on Alipay

Open Alipay and press Civic Center. Choose Nanjing for Location. Scan the QR code to check in and out the station.

Ride metro with "Nanjing Metro QR code" on UnionPay

Open UnionPay app, and select "Nanjing" for your location. Press Travel · Nanjing. Scan the QR code to check in and out the station.

Ride metro with "Nanjing Metro Electronic Card" on Suning Finance

Open Suning Finance app, and press Payment Code and Transport Code to find the Transport Code \cdot Nanjing. Scan the QR code to check in and out the station.





Charge rate

- 1. For each user, no charge within 2 hours, RMB 1 for the third hour; RMB 3 per hour for the fourth hour onwards (less than 1 hour is counted as 1 hour).
- 2. Timing will be refreshed if you lease again after returning the bicycle. You can rent multiple times on the same day, and the lease time is not calculated on an accumulative basis.

Driving

Foreigners holding overseas motor vehicle driving licenses are not allowed to drive in Nanjing before obtaining a Chinese motor vehicle driving license. Foreigners holding Chinese motor vehicle driving licenses are not allowed to drive unlicensed or uncertified motor vehicles.

Interpretation: Foreigners holding overseas motor vehicle driving licenses need to apply for the Chinese motor vehicle driving license to Nanjing Public Security Bureau Traffic Management Department with the applicant's identity documents (Passport, Residence Permit for Hong Kong and Macao Residents or Mainland Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macao Residents, Residence Permit for Taiwan Residents or Mainland Travel Permit for Taiwan Residents, etc.), proof of accommodation registration issued by the public security authority, the overseas motor vehicle driving license (including Chinese translation issued

by a translation agency or notarized by a notary authority for the license in foreign languages), a proof of physical condition issued by a medical establishment within the last six months, and 1 inch color head photo taken in the last six months (or accepting physical examination and taking a photo on site at vehicle administration office). The applicant will be issued with the Chinese motor vehicle driving license after passing the examination.

The applications by members of foreign embassies and consulates in China and representatives of international organizations in China will be subject to the principle of diplomatic equivalence.

Foreigners who do not have a driving license, in addition to the documents mentioned above, need to sign up and pass both the theoretical test and the driving skill test to be issued with a Chinese driving license.



At the foot of Mufu Mountain, along the Yangtze River, you can view the river's landscape at Muyan Binjiang (Riverside). After taking a ferry at Zhongshan Wharf to encounter a sunset, you may visit Yangtze River Ecological Park to closely appreciate the riverside beauty.

Departure Tax Refund

Passengers who are eligible for departure tax refund include foreigners and compatriots from Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan who have resided in mainland China for no more than 183 consecutive days.

Conditions for tax refund application

- 1. The same passenger purchases tax refund items at the same tax refund store on the same day, and the purchase amount reaches the refund threshold of RMB 500. The passenger will obtain the tax refund application form and other tax refund certificates according to the related rules:
- 2. The tax-refundable goods have not been opened or used prior to the departure:
- 3. The departure should be within 90 days of the purchase:
- 4. The tax-refundable goods purchased are taken out of China by the purchaser either through carry-on luggage or checked baggage. Tax refund process
- 1. The passenger should present his or her passport to obtain the Application Form for Tax Refund on Departure from the merchant when purchasing the tax-refundable goods at the dutyfree store:
- 2. When the passenger leaves the country, he/

she will report to the customs, and the customs will review and stamp the Application Form for Tax Refund on Departure:

3. The passenger will apply for the tax refund at the tax refund agency with the passport, the Application Form approved by the customs, and the sales invoice of the tax refundable goods. Tax refund calculation

For tax refundable items purchased by overseas tourists with an applicable tax rate of 13%, the tax refund is calculated with a refund rate of 11% based on the amount of the VAT invoice (VAT included); for those with an applicable tax rate of 9%, the tax refund is calculated with a refund rate of 8% based on the amount of the VAT invoice (VAT included). Nanjing stipulates that the tax refund agency can charge a service fee of 2% of the sales invoice amount (VAT included) of the tax refundable items.

Refund currency and refund method

The currency of tax refund is RMB. Tax refund methods include cash refund and bank transfer refund. For the tax refund amount not exceeding RMB 10.000, overseas tourists can choose cash refund or bank transfer; for the tax refund amount exceeding RMB 10,000, the tax refund will be made by bank transfer.

Two new convenient measures for departure tax refunds: "Instant Refund" and "Easy Payment". Instant Refund: Foreign passengers departing from our city's Lukou International Airport can now enjoy an instant tax refund service. After shopping at the designated pilot stores in our city, the passengers can use the "Instant Refund" mini-program to upload their personal information, account details. and shopping receipts. Upon signing to confirm. they can receive their tax refund on the spot. (Note: The process of customs clearance and verification with the customs authorities and agency at Lukou Airport during departure remains unchanged.) Instant Refund pilot stores: Deji Plaza Co., Ltd., Naniing Xiniiekou Department Store Co., Ltd., Golden Eagle International Retail Group (China) Co., Ltd., Naniing Central Emporium (Group) Stocks Co., Ltd., Nanjing Xianlin Golden Eagle Shopping Center Co., Ltd.

Easy Payment: Foreign passengers departing from Lukou Airport can choose a third payment method for tax refunds in addition to cash and bank transfer. They can use the "Instant Refund" mini-program. scan a QR code at the refund counter, enter their name and credit card information, and upload photos of customs-stamped refund documents. After the counter staff verifies the paper documents, the refund can be processed.

Chapter 6 LIVING IN NANJING



Notice for Foreigners in Nanjing

I. Residence and Stav

by the visa.

1. For a foreigner whose duration of stay specified on the visa does not exceed 180 days, he/ she should stay within the territory of China in accordance with the specified duration of their visa. A foreign national who needs to extend the duration of his/her stay within the territory of China may apply to the Exit-Entry Administration Department of Public Security Authorities under local People's Government at or above county level at least seven (7) days prior to the expiry of duration of stay indicated on his/her visa, and shall submit related materials as required. 2. For a foreigner whose visa specifies that a residence permit is required after entering China, he/she should apply to the Exit-Entry Administration Department of Public Security

A foreign national residing within the territory of China and applying for an extended duration of residence shall apply to the Exit-Entry Administration Department of Public Security Authorities under local People's Government at or above county level level of his/her residence place, at least thirty (30) days prior to the expiry of the effective period of his/her residence permit.

Authorities under local People's Government at or

above county level within the duration specified

and shall submit related materials as required. 3. Foreign nationals reaching the age of 16, if residing or staying within the territory of China. shall take their passport or other international travel documents, or foreign national's residence/ stay permits with them, and allow the public security authorities' inspection of the aforesaid

4. Items to be registered on the residence permit held by a foreign national include his/ her name, gender, date of birth, purpose of residence, duration of residence, date of issue, place of issue, the number of his/her passport or that of any of his/her other international travel certificates. In the case of any changes in the registration items required for the foreign national's residence permit, the permit holder shall apply to the Exit- Entry Administration Department of Public Security Authorities under local People's Government at or above county level of his/ her residence place, and make corresponding changes within 10 days of the change.

5. Foreign nationals residing or staying within the territory of China must not engage in activities that are not consistent with the purpose of residence or stay registered before.

6. After the birth of a foreign baby within the territory of China, his/her parents or

representatives shall take the birth certificate and register the birth within 60 days, at the Public Security Authorities under local People's Government at or above county level of his/her parents' residence place.

They should apply for a residence/stay permit for the baby with the passport at the Exit-Entry Administration Department of the parents' residence place.

- 7. After the death of a foreign national within the territory of China, his/her family, quardians or representatives shall declare with his/her proof of death to the Exit-Entry Administration Department of Public Security Authorities under local People's Government at or above county level, and apply for the nullification of his/her residence or stay permit according to related regulations.
- 8. Foreign nationals must not forge, alter, defraud or fraudulently use visas and certificates.

II. Accommodation Registration

- 9. For foreign nationals checking in at hotels within the territory of China, the hotel shall handle the accommodation registration in accordance with the relevant regulations on maintaining public order at hotels.
- 10. A foreign national residing or staying at a location other than a hotel shall go through the registration formalities by himself/herself, or through the host at the local public security

authorities, within twenty-four (24) hours of the

11. For foreign nationals staying in Nanjing for long term, if they temporarily stay at a location other than their own residence, they shall also go through accommodation registration process.

III. Law and Order

- 12. Foreign nationals staving in Naniing shall not disturb public order, gang up to fight, cause affrays, or insult women.
- 13. Foreign nationals staying in Nanjing shall not disturb public security, carry or store firearms, ammunition or controlled knives.
- 14. Foreign nationals staying in Nanjing shall not infringe others' personal rights, assault others, or illegally restrict others' freedom, or intrude into others' residences.
- 15. Foreign nationals staying in Nanjing shall not take opium, morphine or other drugs, or traffic in or transport drugs.
- 16. Foreign nationals staying in Nanjing shall not involve themselves in prostitution or create conditions for prostitution.
- 17. Foreign nationals staying in Nanjing shall not produce, copy, sell, rent out or disseminate pornographic books, paintings, videos, or any other pornographic materials.
- 18. Foreign nationals rallying, marching, or demonstrating in Nanjing must apply to the Nanjing Public Security Bureau for permission.

Without permission from the public security authorities, foreign nationals shall not involve themselves in rallies, marches or demonstrations held by Chinese citizens.

IV. Religious Activities

19. Foreign nationals can be involved in religious activities held in legally-registered sites of religious activity. Collective religious activities can only be held in the legally-registered temples or churches recognized by the department of religious affairs, or at temporary sites designated by the provincial department of religious affairs. Only at the invitation of religious groups of the provincial level may foreign nationals preach at the sites for religious activities in Nanjing. Foreign nationals who do not report their identity of religious personnel when entering China should also get the approval of the provincial department of religious affairs before they could preach in the legally registered temples or churches.

20. Foreign nationals taking part in religious activities within the territory of China shall abide by Chinese laws and regulations, respect the beliefs and habits of the people in the sites of religious activities, conform to the regulations in the sites of religious activities and submit to the administration of the sites of religious activities.

21. Foreign nationals shall not form any religious organization. establish religious offices or sites for religious activities, or open religious schools within the territory of China, shall not propagate religious belief or appoint religious personnel, or conduct any other missionary activity among Chinese citizens, and shall not recruit students to study abroad for

the purpose of training religious personnel, or distribute religious propaganda materials.

22. Foreign nationals working within the territory

V. Other Affairs

of China shall obtain a work permit and working residence permit according to regulations. No organization or individual is allowed to employ any foreign national who has not obtained a work permit or working residence permit. 23. Foreign nationals holding an international driver's license shall not drive a motor vehicle in Nanjing if they have failed the exam held by Nanjing Public Security Bureau Traffic Management Department and not received a Chinese driver's license. Foreign nationals holding a Chinese driver's license shall not drive any unlicensed or uncertificated motor vehicle. 24. A foreign national shall immediately report a lost or stolen passport to the local public security authorities, and by dint of the case evidence issued by the public security authorities, register at the Exit-Entry Administration Division of Nanjing Public Security Bureau. After investigation and verification, the Exit-Entry Administration Division of Nanjing Public Security Bureau shall issue the Certificate of Missing Passport, and the owner of the lost passport shall apply for a new passport at the embassy

or consulate of his/her mother country in China, before handling visa and other relevant formalities at the Exit-Entry Administration Department of public security authorities.

25. A foreign national shall immediately report lost or stolen property to the local public security authorities, and by dint of the case evidence issued by the public security authorities, register the loss at the Exit-Entry Administration Division of Nanjing Public Security Bureau. After investigation and verification, the Exit-Entry Administration Division of Nanjing Public Security Bureau shall issue a Certificate of Missing Property.

26. As stipulated in Measures for the Administration of Examination and Approval of Foreigners' Permanent Residence in China, the qualified foreigners have the right to apply for the permanent residence identity card for foreigners. The permanent residence identity card for foreigners is the identity document of the holder who resides in China, which can be used for handling affairs such as finance, education, health care, transportation, accommodation, communication, work, tax and social insurance, property registration, and lawsuits.



Pet Keeping

Basic requirements for dog keeping

- 1. Have a permanent residence in this city or a legal certificate of temporary residence in this city.
- 2. Have full capacity for civil conduct.
- 3. Have a fixed residence.
- 4. Dogs of required types (dangerous dogs are not allowed) and numbers (one dog per household).
- 5. To obtain a legal and valid dog immunization certificate, which should be applied for at the dog exemption point recognized by the Municipal Agriculture Committee as required.
- 6. According to the Regulations on the Administration of Dog Raising in Nanjing, dangerous dogs and large dogs (dogs whose shoulder height exceeds 61cm when standing) are not allowed to be registered for dog keeping, and are not allowed to be kept in Nanjing.



Epidemic Prevention Guide

Scientific Approach against Infectious Diseases - Citizens Self-protection Tips (2024 version)

To maintain the health of citizens and foreigners in Nanjing, considering the local situation, here are some key reminders for epidemic prevention:

Wear Masks and Get Vaccinated

During outbreaks of respiratory infectious diseases such as influenza and COVID-19. please practice personal protection, avoid crowded places, and wear masks scientifically and properly. Wear masks when visiting key places like medical institutions, schools. childcare facilities, elderly care and social welfare institutions, or when in contact with people showing respiratory symptoms. If you experience symptoms like fever, sore throat, or cough, wear a mask and seek medical attention promptly. It is recommended to actively get vaccinated against influenza and other diseases to protect your health.

Wash Hands Frequently and Ventilate

Respiratory pathogens can easily spread through droplets when the infected individuals sneeze, cough, or talk, contaminating surfaces. Touching these surfaces and then touching one's eyes, nose, or mouth can lead to infection. Hand washing and disinfection can effectively cut off the transmission routes and reduce the infection risk. Ventilate your spaces 1-2 times daily for 0.5-1 hour each time. Regularly air out and wash your bedding and personal clothing. Maintain personal and collective hygiene, ensuring "garbage goes downstairs" and "daily disposal of daily waste".

Avoid Water Contact, Prevent "Plague God" May to October is the high-risk season for schistosomiasis. Avoid swimming or playing in the Yangtze River and its connected waterways. Skin contact with water containing

schistosomes (the infected water) may lead to schistosomiasis (commonly known as "big belly disease" or "Plague God"). The best prevention is to avoid contact with the infected water. especially in areas with the warning signs. If accidental contact occurs, symptoms like fever, abdominal pain, and diarrhea may appear within a month. Promptly visit a community hospital in the riverside area for schistosomiasis screening. and inform the doctor about the water contact history. For more information on schistosomiasis prevention, please consult local disease control institutions.

Prevent disease vectors according to seasons

Summer and autumn are active seasons for mosquito-borne diseases. When traveling or living in dengue-endemic areas, please wear longsleeved shirts and pants, and apply insect repellent to exposed skin and clothing. Use mosquito nets or screens in rooms. Avoid lingering in shady outdoor areas like tree shadows, bushes, and pavilions during the peak mosquito (especially Aedes albopictus and Aedes aegypti) hours. Protect the environment and don't litter.

Be hygienic to prevent diarrhea

To prevent intestinal infections, follow the "Five Do's" and "Five Don'ts". Five Do's: Eat fresh, well-cooked food; clean and disinfect utensils; Eliminate flies; disinfect drinking water and wash fruits: wash hands before meals and after using the toilet. Five Don'ts: Don't eat raw or undercooked seafood; don't drink untreated water; don't eat food contaminated by flies or spoiled food: don't swim in rivers contaminated with acute intestinal pathogens; don't visit patients with acute intestinal infections.

Prevent tick bites during outdoor activities When outdoors, avoid sitting or lying in tick habitats like grasslands and forests for long periods. For outdoor work or activities, wear

light-colored, smooth long-sleeved clothes and pants, tuck pants into socks, and avoid sandals. Apply repellent to exposed skin. After returning home, carefully check your body, especially the scalp, waist, armpits, groin, and ankles for ticklike growths. Inspect animals (such as pet dog and sheep) for ticks after outdoor activities. If you have a history of tick bites or outdoor activities and develop symptoms like fever, seek medical attention promptly and inform the doctor of the history.

Avoid staying up late and overworking

Prolonged late nights and excessive fatigue not only accelerate aging but also significantly lower immunity. Proper rest, moderate exercise, regular sleep patterns, balanced diet, and ensuring adequate sleep are effective ways to boost immunity and virus resistance, and are prerequisites for a healthy lifestyle.

Maintain a positive attitude for good health

Obtain infectious disease prevention and control policies and advice through official channels (follow the national, provincial, and municipal health departments and CDC websites, WeChat public accounts, or call the health consultation hotline 12320). Fully cooperate with and participate in infectious disease prevention and control measures. Don't believe rumors; don't panic, and maintain psychological balance and a positive mood. When facing psychological issues, seek professional counseling services or communicate more with family and friends.

Stay vigilant in daily prevention

Always maintain personal protection awareness, and do not be careless. Follow the scientific guidelines, make the appropriate protective measures good habits, fully cooperate with and participate in the social epidemic prevention and control measures, and be the primary person taking care of your own health.

Confirmation Form for Accepting Foreign Students Studying in China by Educational Institutions at the Basic Education Stage

The application process is as follows:

1. The documents review

Please send the following documents to NMEB's email (jw202nanjing@126.com): Enrollment Certificate issued by the receiving school, first page of the student's passport, the valid visa page, first page of both parents' passports, and the valid visa pages. Scan all these documents into a single PDF file. NMEB and the exit-entry administration authority will review the materials successively.

2. The form completion

After the approval, NMEB will send a template of JW202 Form and its number to the parent's email. Please input the relevant information on a computer and print four copies of the form. Ensure to accurately fill in the name, passport number, date of birth, and other information

strictly according to the passport.

3. Stamping and Mailing of the form

Please bring four copies of the form to be stamped successively by the receiving school, education bureau of the districts, and NMEB. The responsible person from the receiving school should stamp the admission section of the pages 2, 3, and 4. If the student is enrolled in a school that accepts many foreign students (e.g., schools for international children). the parents can directly come to NMEB for stamping after obtaining the signature and stamp from the receiving school. Express mail all the stamped materials to the Jiangsu Provincial Department of Education. Include a prepaid return express waybill (with the return address filled in) in the package. 





For employers of the provincial or ministerial level, applications should be submitted to the Jiangsu Provincial Department of Science and Technology at Window RC04, Zone C, Jiangsu Provincial Government Service Center, No. 145 Hanzhongmen Street. Tel: +86 25 83666281. Employers registering in Jiangbei New Area (including the Nanjing Area of China (Jiangsu) Pilot Free Trade Zone) should submit applications to the Science and Technology Innovation and Big Data Administration Bureau of Nanjing Jiangbei New Area Administrative Committee of Jiangbei New Area at Window B17/B22, International Talent Service Center, Public Security Hall, F3, Jiangbei New Area Citizen Center, No. 292 Binjiang Avenue, Jiangbei New Area, and the consulting hotline is +86 25 83146818.

Employers registering in Jiangning District should submit applications to Jiangning District Science and Technology Bureau at Window F01, F3, Citizen Center, No. 2 Yangiiayu Road. Jiangning District, and the consulting hotline is

Employers registering in Jiangning Development Zone should submit applications to Jiangning Development Zone Science and Technology Bureau at F1, Building C1, Jiulong Lake International Enterprise Headquarters Park, No. 19 Suyuan Avenue, Jiangning District, and the consulting hotline is +86 25 52110731.

Q: What application procedures should be followed by foreigners in order to work legally in Nanjing?

A: In order to work legally in Nanjing, a foreigner should go through the following procedures:

- (1) Apply for a job and sign an employment contract.
- (2) Apply for the Notification Letter of Foreigner's Work Permit with assistance of the
- (3) Present the Notification Letter of Foreigner's Work Permit and other relevant documents to the embassy or consulate office of the People's Republic of China when applying for a work visa.
- (4) Assisted by the employer, apply for a Foreigner's Work Permit within 15 days of entry into the People's Republic of China holding a work visa.
- (5) Apply for a work-type residence permit, within 30 days of entry into the People's Republic of China holding a work visa. (At the Exit-Entry Administration Department of Nanjing Public Security Bureau. Address: No. 173 Baixia Road, Qinhuai District, Naniing: Telephone: +86 4001001001).

Q: What formalities should Nanjing

municipal units go through in order to legally employ foreigners?

A: (1) The employer should register an account on the Service System for Foreigners Working in China (http://fwp.safea.gov.cn/) submit the registration information, and then bring the original and copies of the required documents to Window 314/315 on the first floor of Nanjing Municipal Government Service Center (Employers registered in Jiangbei New Area (including the Nanjing Area of China (Jiangsu) Pilot Free Trade Zone) should apply at the Jiangbei New Area service point).

- (2) The employer should apply for a Notification Letter of Foreigner's Work Permit on behalf of the prospective foreign employee. Nanjing Science and Technology Bureau: Window 235/236, F1, Nanjing Municipal Government Service Center, No. 265 Middle Jiangdong Road, Jianve District.
- (3) When the Notification Letter of Foreigner's Work Permit is issued, the employer should assist the foreigner to apply for a work visa at the embassy or consulate office of People's Republic of China.
- (4) The employer should apply for a Foreigner's Work Permit for the foreigner, within 15 days of his/her entry into the People's Republic of China holding a work visa. Nanjing Science and Technology Bureau: Window 314/315, F1, Nanjing Municipal Government Service Center, No.265 Middle Jiangdong Road, Jianye District.
- (5) The employer should apply for a work-type residence permit for the foreigner, within 30 days
- of his/her entry into the People's Republic of China holding a work visa. (Address of the Exit-Entry Administration Department of Nanjing Public Security Bureau: No.173 Baixia Road, Qinhuai District, Nanjing; Tel: +86 4001001001).

Q: What materials should the employer submit to get a Notification Letter of Foreigner's Work Permit for the foreigner to be hired?

A: (1) Application Form of Foreigner's Work Permit.

This form should be printed online via the application system, and should be signed by the applicant and stamped by the employer.

(2) Job certifications.

The former employer of the applicant should provide certification about the applicant's work experience pertaining to current employment, including the job position, working period, and previous projects done by the applicant. The certification should be stamped by the former employer or signed by the person in charge. with contact of the certifier (or contact person) enclosed.

For high-end foreign talents (Class A) who

the following criteria in the Evaluation Criteria for Foreigners Employed in China, job qualifications are provided through a commitment system:

a Be selected into the relevant domestic talents program.

b Conform to the internationally recognized standards of professional achievements.

(3) Applicant's certificate of the highest degree (diploma) or relevant approval documents, and professional qualifications.

If the certificate of the highest degree (diploma) is obtained abroad, it should be certified by one of the following authorities:

- Chinese embassy or consulate office.
- · Embassy or consulate office of the foreign country where the applicant obtained the degree certificate or diploma in China.



Chinese diploma authentication authority.
 If the certificate of the highest degree (diploma) is obtained in the Hong Kong SAR, Macao SAR, or Taiwan region, it should be certified by the Chinese diploma authentication authority or local notary agency.

If the certificate of the highest degree (diploma) is obtained in Chinese mainland, only the original certificate is required.

Where pre-approval of the competent authority of industry or professional qualification of the corresponding entry permit is required by Chinese laws and regulations, the approval document of the competent authority of industry or the professional qualification should be provided. (For example, representative offices of foreign enterprises in Nanjing, chief

representative and other representatives of overseas non- governmental organizations, presidents of foreign banks, foreign doctors, and foreign pilots, etc). For high-end foreign talents (Class A) who meet the following criteria in the Evaluation Criteria for Foreigners Employed in China, the certificate of the highest degree (diploma) is provided through a commitment system:

- a Be selected into the relevant domestic talents program.
- b Conform to the internationally recognized standards of professional achievements.
- c Meet the demands of oriented-market encouraged jobs.
- d Innovative and entrepreneurial talents.

(4) Certificate of No Criminal Record of the applicant.

The Certificate of No Criminal Record of the applicant should be provided by the police, national security agency, court, or other departments in the applicant's state of nationality or habitual residence, and should be certified by Chinese embassy or consulate abroad or foreign embassy or consulate in China. The habitual residence refers to the country or region where the application has stayed continuously for more than one year after leaving the state of nationality, excluding Chinese mainland. The Certificate of No. Criminal Record should be issued within 6 months prior to the application acceptance date. Certificate of No Criminal Record issued in the Hong Kong SAR, Macao SAR, or Taiwan region should be notarized by the local notary agency. The Certificate of No Criminal Record without sworn declaration issued by diplomatic organizations (including foreign embassies or consulates in China) is acceptable henceforth no longer needs to be certified. Certificate of No Criminal Record with sworn declaration by the applicant is unacceptable.

Certificate of No Criminal Record with sword declaration by the applicant is unacceptable. In terms of foreign high-end talents (Class A), the Certificate of No Criminal Record is provided through a commitment system.

(5) Health certificate.

The following health certificates should be provided:

- Certificate of Verification on Physical Examination Record for Foreigners or Physical Fitness Certificate issued by China Inspection and Quarantine Office (CIQ).
- Physical Examination Certificate issued by overseas medical institutions recognized by CIQ. All of these health certificates should be issued within 6 months prior to the application acceptance date.

The legal foreigner's physical examination

institution in Nanjing is the Jiangsu International Travel Healthcare Center. (Address: No. 39 Chuangzhi Road; Telephone: +86 25 52345700 / 52345711 / 52345707).

Prior to entry into the People's Republic of China, a commitment system is utilized for health certificates. After entry into the country, however, the applicant should submit a Certificate of Verification on Physical Examination Record for Foreigners or Physical Fitness Certificate issued by CIQ when applying for a Foreigner's Work Permit.

(6) Employment contract or employment certification, including the dispatch letter from a multinational company.

A contract written in the Chinese language is mandatory. It should be signed by the applicant and stamped with the official stamp of the company, and should not be altered. The employment contract or employment certification (including the dispatch letter from a multinational company) should cover necessary information such as the workplace, job duties, salary, work period in China, position, and stamp page (with signature).

The employment certification applies to personnel who carry out agreements or treaties between governments or international organizations, chief representative and other representatives of all kinds of representative offices in China, and overseas contract service providers. Should the employment certification (including the dispatch letter) lacks necessary information, a supplementary document is required.

The dispatch letter applies to professional technicians and senior executives such as managers who are dispatched by the headquarters or regional headquarters of a multinational company from overseas to domestic subsidiaries or branch offices. The dispatch letter should be provided by the

headquarters or regional headquarters of the multinational company.

For professional technicians and senior executives such as managers dispatched by the regional headquarters of a multinational company in China to domestic subsidiaries or branch offices, the dispatch letter and employment contract signed with the regional headquarters of the multinational company should be submitted.

(7) Applicant's passport or international travel document .

The passport should be valid for at least 6 months.

- (8) If accompanied by family members, the applicant should also provide the following supporting materials of the family members.
- Information pages of passport or international travel document of the accompanying family members.
- Proof of family relationship (spouse —
 marriage certificate; child birth certificate or
 adoption certificate; parent or spouse's parent
 birth certificate, marriage certificate, or
 notarized certificate of the applicant).
- Physical examination report (for family members over 18) and digital photos.

 Note: For all of the above non-Chinese materials (except passports or international travel documents), Chinese version of these documents with the official seal of the translation company are mandatory. Both the original material and its Chinese version should be uploaded to the processing system. In the case of change of nationality, the foreigner should reapply for a work permit in China.
- Q: The employer has applied for a Notification Letter of Foreigner's Work Permit for the foreigner to be hired. In this

case, what materials should be submitted to get a Foreigner's Work Permit?

- **A:** (1) Application Form of Foreigner's Work Permit (original). This form should be printed online via the application system, and should be signed by the applicant and stamped by the employer.
- (2) Copy of the Notification Letter of Foreigner's Work Permit.
- (3) Original of applicant's passport, and copies of its information page and work visa page.
- (4) Employment contract (original and copy).
- (5) Health certificate (original and copy).

 The applicant should provide a Certificate of
 Verification on Physical Examination Record for
 Foreigners or Physical Fitness Certificate issued
 by CIQ, which should be issued within 6 months
 prior to the application acceptance date.
- (6) Applicant's certificate of the highest degree (diploma) or the relevant approval documents, professional qualifications, and embassy or consulate certification (originals).
- (7) Certificate of No Criminal Record and embassy or consulate certification (originals).
- Q: What materials should the employer submit to extend the validity period of a Foreigner's Work Permit for the foreigner to be hired?
- **A:**(1) Application Form for Extension of Foreigner's Work Permit (original). This form should be printed online via the application system, and should be signed by the applicant and stamped by the employer.
- (2) Original of applicant's passport, and copies of its information page, visa page, last entry stamp page, or valid residence permit page.
- (3) Employment contract (original and copy).
- (4) Original of the Foreigner's Work Permit, including the Foreign Expert Certificate or Alien

Employment Permit within the current validity period.

Note: To extend the current validity period of the Foreign Expert Certificate or Alien Employment Permit, the applicant's certificate of the highest degree and its Chinese translation (with the official seal of the employer) are required.

Q: In the case that a foreigner has lost his/ her work permit, what materials should the employer submit for the renewal of a Foreigner's Work Permit?

A: (1) Application Form for Renewal of Foreigner's Work Permit (original). This form should be printed online via the application system, and should be signed by the applicant and stamped by the employer.

(2) Description of the applicant's loss or damage (original).

Note: In the case of loss of a work permit, the applicant should make a declaration on the Service System for Foreigners Working in China as of the date of loss or discovery of loss, and apply to Nanjing Municipal Science and Technology Bureau for renewal. In the case of damage of a work permit, the original work permit is required when the renewal application is submitted.

Q: If the content of the Foreigner's Work Permit changes, what materials should the employer submit to change the information in the work permit?

- A: (1) Application Form for Change of Foreigner's Work Permit (original). This form should be printed online via the application system, and should be signed by the applicant and stamped by the employer.
- (2) Supporting documents for items to be

changed (original).

Note: Where there are changes in applicant's personal information (such as name, passport number, job position, category), the application should be filed to Nanjing Municipal Science and Technology Bureau no more than 10 workdays after the change.

Q: If the employment relationship between the foreigner and employer is canceled, what materials should the employer submit to cancel the Foreigner's Work Permit?

A: (1) Application Form for Cancellation of Foreigner's Work Permit (original). This form should be printed online via the application system, and should be signed by the applicant and stamped by the employer.

(2) Supporting materials for the cancellation of employment relationship, termination of contract, or other documents related to the reason of the cancellation (original). In terms of cancellation of employment relationship and termination of the contract, signatures of both parties are required.

Note: If a Foreigner's Work Permit fails to be extended at the expiry of its validity period, it should be canceled automatically. The revocation, withdrawal, and suspension of work permit in accordance with law should be performed by the Nanjing Municipal Science and Technology Bureau. Where a foreign applicant dies, loses his or her capacity for action, terminates the contract in advance, or cancels the employment relationship, the employer should apply to the Nanjing Foreign Experts Bureau for cancellation within 10 workdays from the date of occurrence of such facts. If an employer is terminated. the applicant may apply to the Nanjing Municipal Science and Technology Bureau for cancellation of work permit.



Social Insurance

I. Who needs to participate in the insurance?

A: Foreigners lawfully employed by enterprises, institutions, social organizations, private non-enterprise units, foundations, law firms, accounting firms and other organizations registered in China shall participate in basic pension insurance, basic medical insurance, work injury insurance, unemployment insurance and maternity insurance, and the employer and the employee shall pay social insurance premiums as required.

After entering into an employment contract with an overseas employer, the foreigner who is assigned to work in a branch or representative office registered in China shall also participate in social insurance according to law.

II. How do employers apply insurance for

foreign employees?

A: After the foreigner is employed by the employer in Nanjing, the employer should bring his or her valid passport and other valid identity documents such as Foreigner's Work Permit in China or Permanent Residence Permit to apply for social insurance registration at the social insurance agency where the employer is registered. If there is a mutual exemption agreement, the employer must provide the original and a copy of the mutual exemption agreement.

III. How to determine the contribution base?

A: 1. All types of insurances under the social insurance framework use the same contribution base. A new employee's insurance will be based on his/her very first monthly salary.

from the second year onwards, the monthly contribution base for the current settlement year (January to December) will be declared by dividing the total salary income of the employee in the previous natural year by the actual number of months of salary paid. The contribution base declared by the employer should be known to the employee either through the latter's confirmation or public announcement.

- 2. According to the National Bureau of Statistics, the total wage income of employees include: hourly wages, piecework wages, bonuses, allowances and subsidies, such as overtime wages, wage income paid under special circumstances and so on.
- 3. The city human resources and social security department announces the upper and lower limits of the contribution base every year. If the employee's salary income exceeds the upper limit, it will not be included in the individual contribution base; if the employee's salary income is lower than the lower limit, the employee's individual contribution base will be determined according to the lower limit. The employer shall declare its contribution base according to the actual salary income of the employees. If the declared contribution base is higher than the upper limit or lower than the lower limit, it will be adjusted by the agency after the upper and lower limit of the contribution base is determined.

IV. How to transfer and continue the social insurance relationship?

A: If foreigners leave Jiangsu Province for cross-region employment after suspending their pension insurance relationship, they can apply directly to the social insurance agency in the place of transfer or apply by logging on to the National Social Insurance Public Service Platform (http:isi.12333.gov.cn/), "12333 app" and Alipay. When foreigners apply for the transfer of basic pension insurance relationship, they are not restricted by the regulations of men under 50 years old and women under 40 years old.

V. How do foreigners enjoy social insurance benefits?

A: Foreigners who participate in social insurance can enjoy social insurance benefits if they meet the requirements. Foreigners who leave China before reaching the required pension age, can retain their personal social insurance account, and if they come to China for employment again, the number of years of contributions will be calculated in an accumulative manner; if they apply in writing to terminate the social insurance relationship, they can also obtain the amount stored in their personal social insurance account to themselves in a lump sum.

Foreign Investment Policies

Headquarters Policy

In accordance with the relevant regulations. the recognized municipal-level headquarters enterprises can enjoy six reward policies including headquarters settlement, R&D headquarters, business contribution. upgrading, talent incentives, and office space subsidies, as well as four service measures including accelerated land use, financing services, customs facilitation, and priority recommendations.

Financial Policy

Focusing on four major directions: major project implementation, key industry development, strengthening and extending industrial chains. and cultivating scientific and innovative talents. a "4+N" industrial fund cluster with a total scale exceeding 200 billion yuan has been created. Financial institutions settling in the area can receive rewards of up to 50 million yuan. Equity investment firms settling in the area can receive start-up rewards of up to 15 million yuan, with the qualified firms eligible for investment rewards of up to 5 million yuan and merger and acquisition rewards of up to 1

million yuan. The enterprises going public for the first time in domestic or international multilevel capital markets can receive support of up to 4 million yuan.

Science and Innovation Policy

For the approved national and provinciallevel industrial innovation centers, technology innovation centers, and manufacturing innovation centers, 1:1 matching support is provided based on the funds allocated by the national and provincial governments. The subsidy amount is shared equally between the city and its districts. In Jiangbei New Area, the entire subsidy amount is borne by the New Area. For municipal-level major science and technology projects, support of up to 20 million yuan is provided. In addition. support is given to the new R&D institutions collaborating with key enterprises in the industrial chain, universities, and research institutes for technological breakthroughs. product development, and application scenario construction, with up to 3 million yuan provided for the individual projects.

Nanjing's comprehensive pilot program to expand the opening up

of the service industry

In December 2022, the State Council approved Nanjing and five other cities to carry out the national comprehensive pilot program to expand the opening-up of the service industry.

Nanjing became the only city in Jiangsu Province to combine two major national opening-up strategies; the "Comprehensive Pilot Program to Expand the Opening-up of the Service Industry" and the"Pilot Free Trade Zone". The program includes 104 tasks covering 10 service industry sectors. including science and technology, education, finance, healthcare, information and data, and talent,
